Dr Isabelle Nault is a cardiologist electrophysiologist at Quebec Heart and Lung Institute (IUCPQ) since 2009.

She completed her Medical degree at Laval University in Quebec, Canada in 2001. She then did her Cardiology training at IUCPQ / Laval University, followed by a two years fellowship in electrophysiology at the Université Bordeaux 2 / Hospital Haut Leveque in Bordeaux-Pessac, France, with Professor Michel Haissaguerre.

She is particularly involved with complex atrial and ventricular arrhythmia ablations. Her publications focus mainly on ventricular tachycardia and atrial fibrillation. She also has interest in radiation protection and radiation reduction during electrophysiology procedures.

She presented to many international and national conferences, including the Heart Rhythm Society, Cardiostim, the Japanese Heart Rhythm Society, the Canadian Cardiovascular Congress and the Quebec Cardiology Association.
